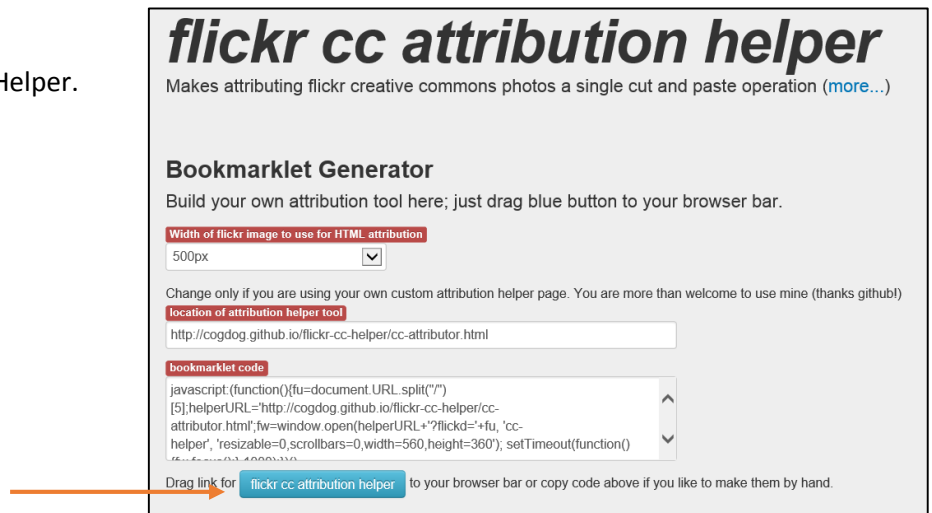


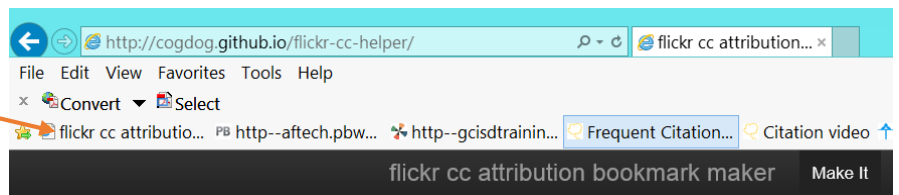
Flickr CC Attribution Helper (<http://cogdog.github.io/flickr-cc-helper>)

Use the bookmarklet to easily attribute a photo. It provides embed code for a website as well as license information in text format for a WORD or PPT document. The only downside of the embed code is that the choose your size option does not work.

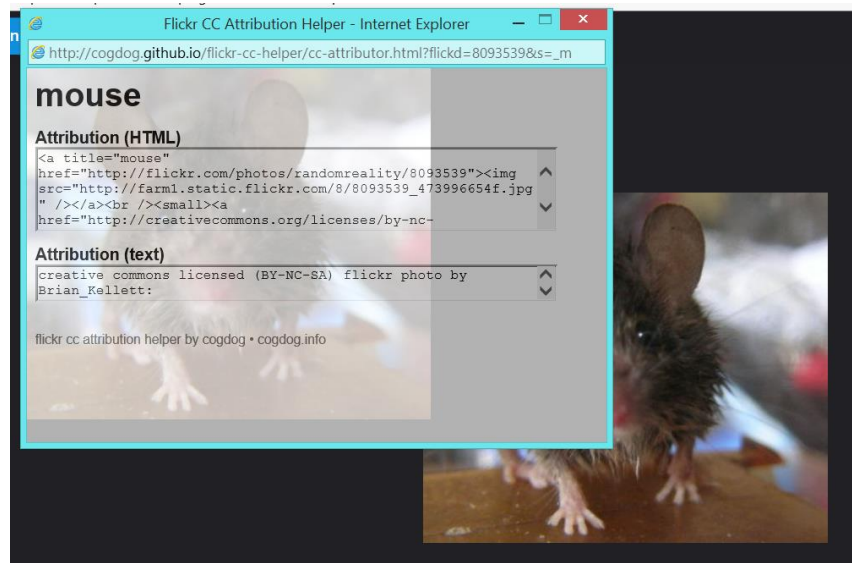
1. Go to Flickr CC Attribution Helper.



2. Drag the blue bokmarklet to your toolbar.



3. Find an image in Flickr and click on the image. Then click on the bookmarklet on your toolbar. If the image is in the Flickr Creative Commons, you will get a pop up box with the embed code and the license information in text format. You will also be told if the image does not have a Creative Commons license.



4. Copy the embed code and insert it into your website.

5. Or insert the photo into a WORD or PPT document using the instruction outlined in the Flickr document. Copy the “text” license information and paste it below the photo.
